During this period, she represented Greece in WIPO and European Union instruments dealing with copyright policy issues, and she drafted amendments to copyright legislation (including a draft implementation of EU Directive 2019/790/ "DSM copyright" the EU Directive 2019/789/ "Satcab directive" into national law).

She has been an Adjunct Lecturer at the Department of Computer Science of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) since 2018, a lecturer on contract in Postgraduate studies at the University of Piraeus since 2017 and has taught in many other academic courses.

She is the Vice President of the Hellenic Association of Data Protection & Privacy (HADPP), and an elected member of the Administrative Council of the Greek branch of the International Literary and Artistic Association (ALAI) since 2015.
